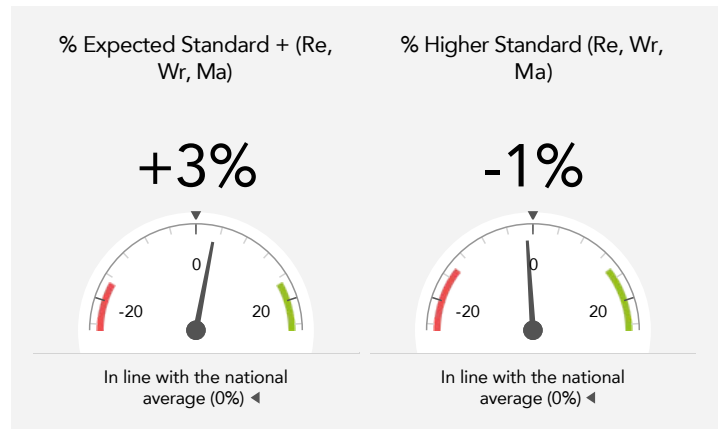

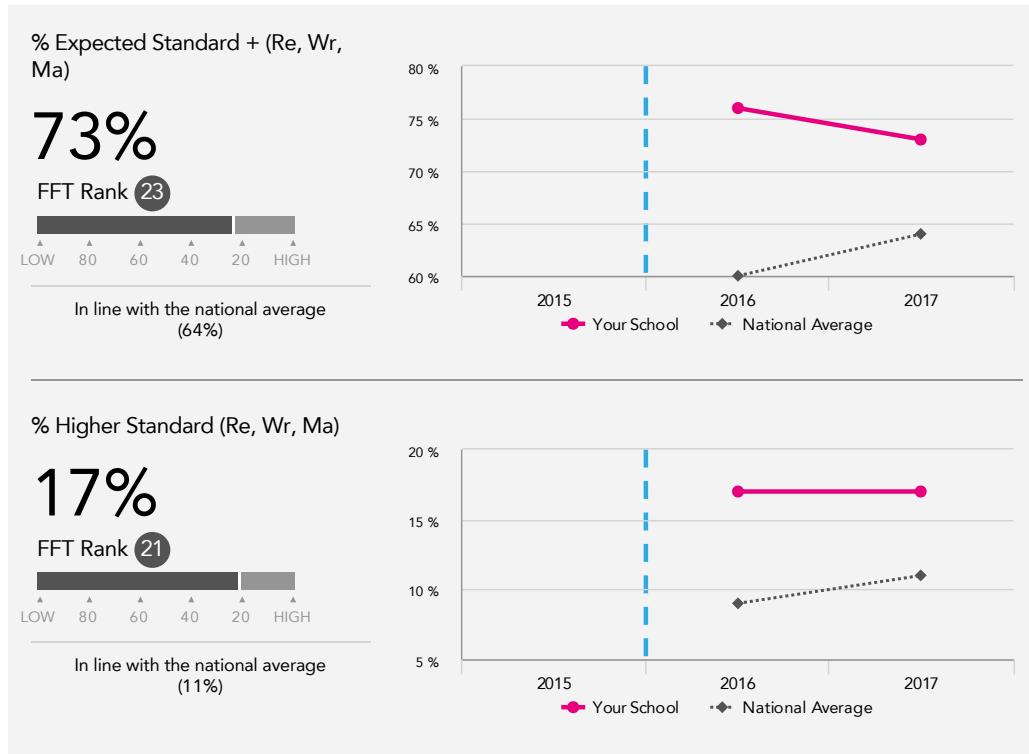

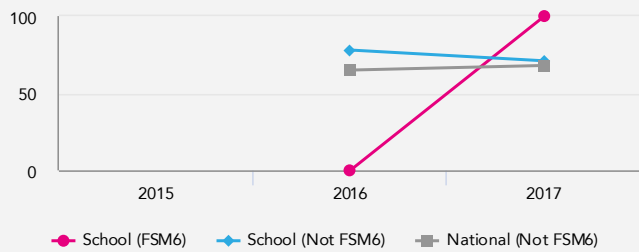

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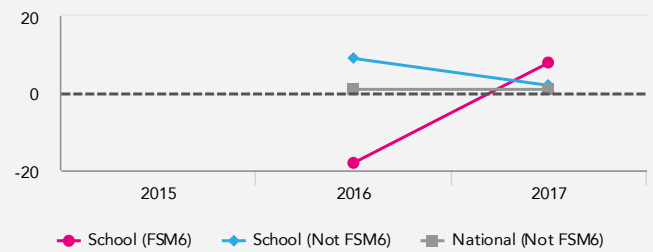

Attainment: % Expected Standard + (Re, Wr, Ma)

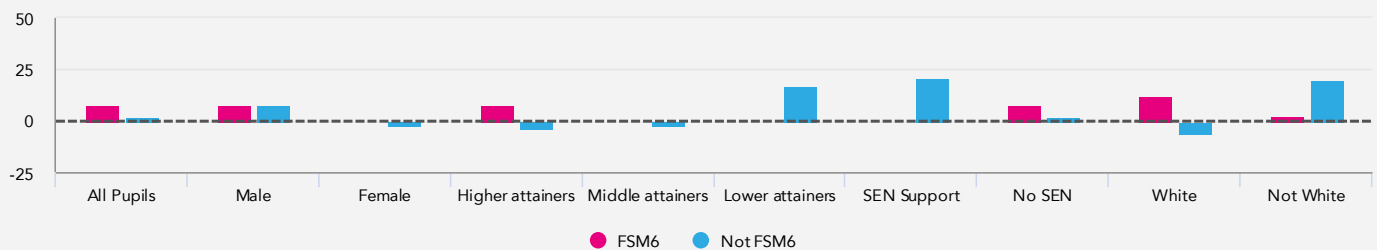


Progress: % Expected Standard + (Re, Wr, Ma)

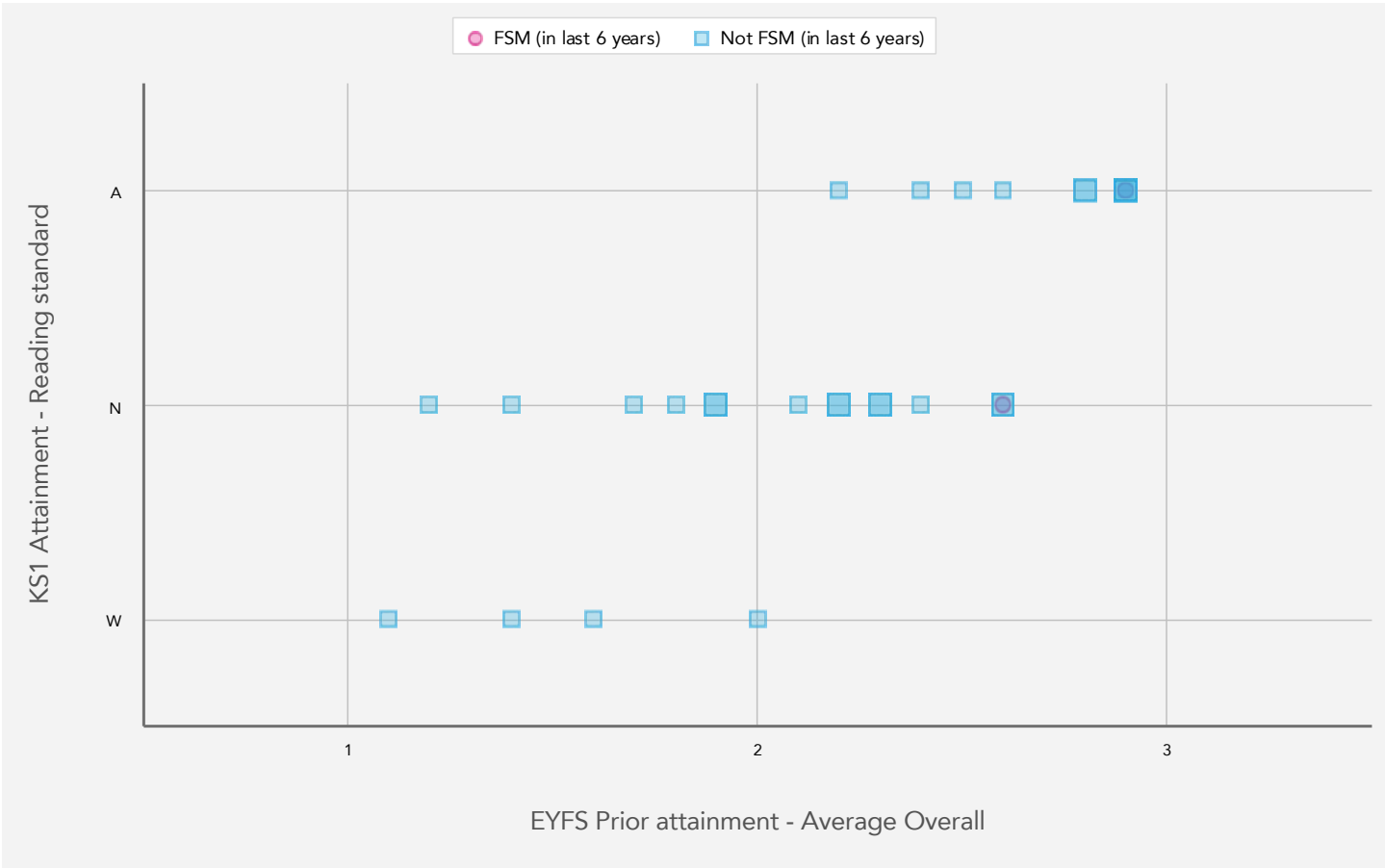
